





In the EU victims are not always aware of their rights

and possibilities to receive support from the very beginning of the criminal proceedings.

Therefore, a remaining challenge is to ensure that all victims obtain adequate information that meets their individual needs and circumstances right from the start.

Since 2012 the EU Member States were expected to implement Victims' Rights Directive and continue developing services for victims of crimes.

10 years since the Directive was adopted, Member States are still seemingly failing to provide basic generic services for victims. Incidental evidence available to the BeneVict partnership indicates that in a majority of states victims experiences are hardly improving.
